Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 203 - 215
and insert:
~~reasonable in light of the potential benefit to the patient. If~~
a patient is younger than 18 years of age:7

a. A second physician must concur with this determination,
and such determination must be documented in the patient's
medical record;
