23	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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25	Section 1. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 322.032,
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Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

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322.032 Digital proof of driver license.-

28 (1) (a) The department, in collaboration with the Agency 29 for State Technology, shall establish and implement begin to 30 review and prepare for the development of a secure and uniform 31 protocols and standards system for issuing an optional digital 32 proof of driver license, and procure any application programming 33 interface necessary for enabling a private entity to securely 34 manufacture a digital proof of driver license. The department 35 may contract with one or more private entities to develop a 36 digital proof of driver license system.

37 (b) The Agency for State Technology, in collaboration with the department, shall maintain and publish on its website the 38 39 protocols and standards necessary for a private entity to 40 request authorized access to an application programming 41 interface necessary for the private entity to manufacture a 42 digital proof of driver license. The agency shall timely review 43 and approve or reject such request. Upon approval, the agency 44 shall designate a private entity as an authorized manufacturer 45 of digital proofs of driver licenses.

46 (c) Revenue generated from the sale or renewal of a 47 digital proof of driver license must be collected at the point 48 of sale or renewal by an authorized manufacturer of digital 49 proofs of driver licenses and such revenue must be shared with 50 the state on a revenue-sharing basis. Such authorized

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51	manufacturer is responsible for remitting 50 percent of all
52	revenue collected when a digital proof of driver license is sold
53	or renewed for deposit into the General Revenue Fund. The Agency
54	for State Technology, in collaboration with the Department of
55	Management Services, shall enter into an agreement with such
56	authorized manufacturer that sets forth the permitted uses,
57	terms and conditions, privacy policy, and uniform remittance
58	terms relating to the manufacture of a digital proof of driver
59	license.
60	(2) <u>A</u> <del>The</del> digital proof of driver license <del>developed by the</del>
61	department or by an entity contracted by the department must be
62	in such a format as to allow law enforcement to verify the
63	authenticity of the digital proof of driver license. The
