12	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

14	Section 1. (1) The Environmental Laboratory Trust Fund
15	within the Department of Environmental Protection, FLAIR number
16	20-2-050001, is terminated.
17	(2) All current balances remaining in, and all revenues
18	of, the trust fund shall be transferred to the Grants and
19	Donations Trust Fund within the Department of Environmental
20	Protection.
21	(3) The Department of Environmental Protection shall pay
22	any outstanding debts or obligations of the terminated trust
23	fund as soon as practicable, and the Chief Financial Officer
24	shall close out and remove the terminated trust fund from
25	various state accounting systems using generally accepted

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accounting principles concerning warrants outstanding, assets,
and liabilities.
Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 20.25501, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:
20.25501 Department of Environmental Protection; trust
fundsThe following trust funds shall be administered by the
Department of Environmental Protection:
(3) The Environmental Laboratory Trust Fund.
(a) The trust fund is established for use as a depository
for funds to be used for the operation of the department's
environmental laboratory program and is funded by program
revenues and assessments against trust funds.
(b) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351,
any balance in the trust fund at the end of a fiscal year shall
remain in the trust fund and shall be available for carrying out
the purpose of the trust fund.
Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
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
