19	(1) Subject to legislative appropriation, the Department
20	of Veterans' Affairs shall contract with one or more
21	individuals, corporations not for profit, state universities, or
22	Florida College System institutions to provide alternative
23	treatment options for veterans who have been certified by the
24	United States Department of Veterans Affairs or any branch of
25	the United States Armed Forces as having a traumatic brain

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26	injury or posttraumatic stress disorder. For purposes of this
27	section, the term "alternative treatment" means a therapeutic
28	service that is not part of the standard of medical care
29	established by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
30	for treating traumatic brain injury or posttraumatic stress
31	disorder but has been shown by at least one scientific or
32	medical peer-reviewed study to have some positive effect on
33	traumatic brain injury or posttraumatic stress disorder.
34	Alternative treatment must be provided under the direction and
35	supervision of an individual licensed under chapter 458, chapter
36	459, chapter 460, chapter 464, chapter 490, or chapter 491.
37	(2) Each contracted individual or entity shall report
38	annually to the department each alternative treatment provided,
39	the number of veterans served, and the treatment outcomes.
