20	there are at least 30 consecutive minutes per day. <u>Physical</u>
21	education for students in kindergarten through grade 3 may
22	include free-play recess. Beginning with the 2009-2010 school
23	year, The equivalent of one class period per day of physical
24	education for one semester of each year is required for students
25	enrolled in grades 6 through 8. Students enrolled in such

26 instruction shall be reported through the periodic student 27 membership surveys, and records of such enrollment shall be 28 audited pursuant to s. 1010.305. Such instruction may be 29 provided by any instructional personnel as defined in s. 30 1012.01(2), regardless of certification, who are designated by 31 the school principal.

32 (6) In addition to the requirements in subsection (3), 33 each district school board shall provide free-play recess each 34 week on days when physical education classes are not held for 35 students in kindergarten through grade 3 so that there are at 36 least 20 consecutive minutes of free-play recess.
