6 Section 6. Section 717.113, Florida Statutes, is amended
7 to read:

8 717.113 Property held by courts and public agencies.—All
9 intangible property held for the owner by any court, government
10 or governmental subdivision or agency, public corporation, or
11 public authority that has not been claimed by the owner for more
12 than 1 year after it became payable or distributable is presumed
13 unclaimed. Except as provided in s. 45.032(3)(c), money held in
14 the court registry and for which no court order has been issued
15 to determine an owner does not become payable or distributable
16 and is not subject to reporting under this chapter.

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17 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, funds deposited
18 in the Minerals Trust Fund pursuant to s. 377.247 are presumed
19 unclaimed only if the funds have not been claimed by the owner
20 for more than 5 years after the date of first production from
21 the well.
