

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to transportation facility
 3 designations; providing honorary designations of
 4 various transportation facilities in specified
 5 counties; directing the Department of Transportation
 6 to erect suitable markers; amending ch. 2014-228, Laws
 7 of Florida, and ch. 26497, Laws of Florida (1951);
 8 revising honorary designations of transportation
 9 facilities in specified counties; directing the
 10 department to erect suitable markers; providing an
 11 effective date.

 13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

14
 15 Section 1. Transportation facility designations;
 16 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

17 (1) That portion of U.S. 98/S.R. 30 between Ryan Drive/W.
 18 11th Street and N.E./S.E. 12th Street in Franklin County is
 19 designated as "SP4 Robert Clifford Millender Memorial Highway."

20 (2) That portion of S.R. 53 between U.S. 90/S.R. 10 and
 21 the Georgia state line in Madison County is designated as "Joe
 22 C. Peavy Memorial Highway."

23 (3) That portion of U.S. 129/S.R. 51 between I-75 in
 24 Hamilton County and I-10 in Suwannee County is designated as
 25 "Historic Suwannee River Scenic Parkway."

26 (4) That portion of U.S. 19/98/S.R. 55 between N. Otter
27 Creek Avenue and S.E. 1st Avenue in Levy County is designated as
28 "Deputy Sheriff Atticus Hagood Ellzey Memorial Highway."

29 (5) That portion of Miami Avenue between N.E. 5th Street
30 and S.E. 7th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated as
31 "Robert L. Shevin Memorial Highway."

32 (6) That portion of U.S. 98/S.R. 30 between Rosewood Drive
33 in Okaloosa County and Sunrise Drive in Santa Rosa County is
34 designated as "Warren E. 'Charlie' and Shirley Brown Memorial
35 Highway."

36 (7) That portion of S.R. 349 between U.S. 98/S.R. 55 in
37 Dixie County and S.R. 20 in Lafayette County is designated as
38 "Joe Anderson, Jr., Memorial Highway."

39 (8) That portion of C.R. 431/Pine Hills Road between
40 Silver Star Road and S.R. 50 in Orange County is designated as
41 "Deputy First Class Norman Lewis Memorial Highway."

42 (9) That portion of S.R. 438 between John Young Parkway
43 and Pine Hills Road in Orange County is designated as
44 "Lieutenant Debra Clayton Memorial Highway."

45 (10) Bridge number 570175 on 77th Special Forces Way over
46 State Road 85 in Okaloosa County is designated as "Brigadier
47 General Thomas 'Mark' Stogsdill Memorial Overpass."

48 (11) SunRail Bridge number 750255 over U.S. 17/92/S.R. 15
49 in Orange County is designated as "Reverend Kenneth C. Crossman
50 Bridge."

51 (12) That portion of U.S. 29/Pensacola Boulevard between W
52 Street and Marcus Pointe Boulevard/Stumpfield Road in Escambia
53 County is designated as "Wilbur Barry Highway."

54 (13) That portion of U.S. 19 between the Pinellas County
55 line and the Hernando County line in Pasco County is designated
56 as "Gulf Coast Highway."

57 (14) Bridge number 860920 over the Stranahan River in
58 Broward County is designated as "John U. Lloyd Bridge."

59 (15) That portion of the Homestead extension of the
60 Florida Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Milepost 34 and Milepost 36 in
61 Miami-Dade County is designated as "Trooper Patrick Ambroise
62 Memorial Highway."

63 (16) That portion of S.R. 80 between Hickey Creek Road and
64 Carter Lane in Lee County is designated as "Corporal Joseph R.
65 Bertrand Memorial Highway."

66 (17) That portion of I-75/S.R. 93A between Fowler Avenue
67 and Fletcher Avenue in Hillsborough County is designated as
68 "Lieutenant Benedict J. Thomas Memorial Highway."

69 (18) That portion of S.R. 60/Causeway Boulevard between
70 the Hillsborough County line and Mandalay Avenue in Pinellas
71 County is designated as "Purple Heart Trail."

72 (19) That portion of S.R. 19 between S.R. 50 and C.R.
73 478/Cherry Lake Road in Lake County is designated as "Sergeant
74 Marvin L. Roberts Memorial Highway."

75 (20) That portion of U.S. 41/S.R. 90/S.W. 8th Street

76 between S.W. 53rd Avenue and S.W. 56th Avenue in Miami-Dade
 77 County is designated as "Lorenzo de Toro Way."

78 (21) That portion of S.W. 22nd Street between S.R.
 79 933/S.W. 12th Avenue and S.W. 13th Avenue in Miami-Dade County
 80 is designated as "Luis Fernando Brande Street."

81 (22) That portion of U.S. 441/S.R. 7 between N.W. 52nd
 82 Street and N.W. 65th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated
 83 as "Muhammad Ali Boulevard."

84 (23) That portion of S.R. 922/N.E. 123rd Street/N.E. 125th
 85 Street between N.E. 10th Avenue and N. Bayshore Drive in Miami-
 86 Dade County is designated as "Stanley G. Tate Boulevard."

87 (24) That portion of U.S. 27/S.R. 25 between W. 9th Street
 88 and E./S.E. 1st Avenue within the City of Hialeah in Miami-Dade
 89 County is designated as "Herman Echevarria Way."

90 (25) That portion of S. Krome Avenue between S.W. 344th
 91 Street and S.W. 177th Court in Miami-Dade County is designated
 92 as "Robert M. Levy Memorial Boulevard."

93 (26) That portion of U.S. 1 between Broward Boulevard and
 94 Sunrise Boulevard in Broward County is designated as "Hope and
 95 Healing Highway."

96 (27) Bridge numbers 900110 and 900111 over Pine Channel on
 97 U.S. 1/S.R. 5 in Monroe County are designated as the "Irene U.
 98 Hooper Memorial Bridges."

99 (28) That portion of S.R. 408 between Kirkman Road and
 100 Clarke Road in Orange County is designated as "Arnold Palmer

101 Expressway."

102 (29) Bridge number 380096 over the Econfina River on U.S.
 103 221/S.R. 55 in Taylor County is designated as "Private First
 104 Class Joey Moody Bridge."

105 (30) That portion of Palm Avenue between Pembroke Road and
 106 Miramar Parkway in Broward County is designated as "Candice
 107 Ellize Francois Street."

108 (31) That portion of S.R. 9/N.W. 27th Avenue between S.R.
 109 934/N.W. 79th Street and N.W. 41st Street in Miami-Dade County
 110 is designated as "Georgia Ayers Way."

111 (32) That portion of N.W. 32nd Avenue between N.W. 87th
 112 Street and N.W. 83rd Street in Miami-Dade County is designated
 113 as "Dr. Clifford Garfield O'Connor Street."

114 (33) That portion of U.S. 441/S.R. 7 between N.W. 155th
 115 Lane and N.W. 151st Street in Miami-Dade County is designated as
 116 "Robert 'Bobby' L. Parker, Sr., Memorial Highway."

117 (34) That portion of U.S. 441/S.R. 500/Orange Blossom
 118 Trail between Lake View Drive/Lake Street and S.R. 451 in Orange
 119 County is designated as "Anelie Cadet Way."

120 (35) That portion of S.R. 909/W. Dixie Highway between
 121 N.E. 6th Avenue and N.E. 10th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is
 122 designated as "Phares Duverne Highway."

123 (36) That portion of N.W. 2nd Avenue between N.W. 103rd
 124 Street and N.W. 111th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated
 125 as "Carmelau Monestime Street."

126 (37) That portion of 27th Avenue between 54th Street and
 127 215th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Jessie Trice
 128 Way."

129 (38) Bridge number 870054 on S.R. 112/W. 41st
 130 Street/Arthur Godfrey Road in Miami-Dade County is designated as
 131 "Senator Paul B. Steinberg Bridge."

132 (39) That portion of U.S. 41/S.R. 45/Tamiami Trail between
 133 Corkscrew Road and Coconut Road in Lee County is designated as
 134 "Coach Jeff Sommer Memorial Highway."

135 (40) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
 136 suitable markers designating the transportation facilities as
 137 described in this section.

138 Section 2. Section 28 of chapter 2014-228, Laws of
 139 Florida, is amended to read:

140 Section 28. Reverend Wilner Maxy ~~Maxi~~ Street designated;
 141 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

142 (1) That portion of N.E. 73rd Street between N.E. 2nd
 143 Avenue and N.E. 3rd Court in Miami-Dade County is designated as
 144 "Reverend Wilner Maxy ~~Maxi~~ Street."

145 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
 146 suitable markers designating Reverend Wilner Maxy ~~Maxi~~ Street as
 147 described in subsection (1).

148 Section 3. Section 1 of chapter 26497, Laws of Florida
 149 (1951), is amended to read:

150 Section 1. That the following described route be and the

151 same is hereby declared, designated and established as a State
152 Road, forming a part of the connecting system of the State of
153 Florida, and shall be known as the SHEPARD BROAD CAUSEWAY
154 ~~BOULEVARD~~.

155 Beginning at the intersection of State Road AIA and 96th
156 Street in Dade County, Florida, and running in a Westerly
157 direction, as nearly ~~near~~ as possible in a direct line, through
158 the Town of Bay Harbor Islands, Florida, across Broad Causeway,
159 spanning Biscayne Bay, and through the Town of North Miami,
160 Florida, to the point where such highway shall intersect with
161 State Road Number 7, along the most practicable and feasible
162 route to be determined by the State Road Department.

163 Section 4. The Department of Transportation is directed to
164 erect suitable markers correcting the designation of the
165 transportation facility pursuant to the amendment made by this
166 act to section 1 of chapter 26497, Laws of Florida (1951).

167 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
