with chapter 617. The Tampa Success Zone is not subject to control, supervision, or direction by any department of the state in any manner. The Legislature determines, however, that public policy dictates that the corporation operate in the most open and accessible manner consistent with its public purpose. Therefore, the Legislature declares that the corporation is subject to chapter 119, relating to public records, chapter 286, relating to public meetings and records, and chapter 287, relating to procurement of commodities or contractual services.

- (b) The Tampa Success Zone is designed to encompass an area that is large enough to include all of the necessary components of community life, including, but not limited to, schools, places of worship, recreational facilities, commercial areas, and common space, yet small enough to allow programs and services to reach every member of the neighborhood who is willing to participate in the project.
 - $(12) \frac{(11)}{(11)}$ IMPLEMENTATION.—

(a) The Miami Children's Initiative, Inc., the New Town Success Zone, and the Parramore Kidz Zone, and the Tampa Success Zone have been designated as Florida Children's Initiatives consistent with the legislative intent and purpose of s. 16, chapter 2009-43, Laws of Florida, and as such shall each assist the disadvantaged areas of the state in creating a community-based service network and programming that develops, coordinates, and provides quality education, accessible health

care, youth development programs, opportunities for employment, and safe and affordable housing for children and families living within their boundaries.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
