WHEREAS, the Department of Law Enforcement reports that in 2015 violent crime posed a serious danger to Floridians, with 1,040 homicides, 7,537 rapes, 60,539 aggravated assaults, and 21,097 robberies committed in Florida, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Bureau of Investigation states that in 2015 approximately 1,197,704 violent crimes occurred throughout the United States, including 15,696 homicides, 124,047 rapes, 764,449 aggravated assaults, and 327,374 robberies, and

WHEREAS, more than 2,600 of the people killed in violent crimes each year are children age 19 or younger, such as the homicide on August 30, 2016, in which 8-year-old Jada Page was killed in a drive-by shooting in Miami, and

WHEREAS, the public has been horrified and saddened by the mass shooting events such as the one on June 12, 2016, in which 49 people were killed and 53 people were wounded in the Pulse nightclub in Orlando, and

WHEREAS, Florida has the 5th highest violent crime rate and the 14th highest homicide rate in the United States, and
