6	WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of
7	death in the United States, killing more people than breast
8	cancer and prostate cancer combined, and
9	WHEREAS, 5.4 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's
10	disease, the vast majority of whom are 65 years of age and
11	older, and
12	WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association reports that Florida
13	had the second highest prevalence rate of Alzheimer's disease in
14	the nation in 2016, with more than 510,000 Floridians living
15	with the disease and that number expected to rise to 720,000 by
16	2025, and
17	WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association projects that, in the
18	absence of the development of medical interventions to prevent
19	or cure the disease, the number of Americans living with
20	Alzheimer's disease will nearly triple by 2050, and
21	WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the only disease among the
22	top 10 causes of death in the nation which cannot be prevented,
23	cured, or slowed, and
24	WHEREAS, in 2015, family members and friends for each
25	person living with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of

26	dementia collectively provided 18.1 billion hours of unpaid care
27	to all such patients, where approximately two-thirds of these
28	caregivers were women and over one-third were 65 years of age or
29	older, and
30	WHEREAS, the Alzheimer's Association reports that
31	Alzheimer's disease is one of the costliest chronic diseases and
32	poses a significant burden on our nation and state, and
33	WHEREAS, nationwide, the medical costs spent on people
34	living with Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia will
35	more than double by 2050, NOW, THEREFORE,

37	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of

40	That June 18-24, 2017, is designated as "Alzheimer's
41	Disease and Dementia Awareness Week."
