Between lines 46 and 47 of the amendment, insert:

Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 562.11, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

562.11 Selling, giving, or serving alcoholic beverages to person under age 21; providing a proper name; misrepresenting or misstating age or age of another to induce licensee to serve alcoholic beverages to person under 21; penalties.—

(1)(a)1. A person may not sell, give, serve, or permit to be served alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age or permit a person under 21 years of age to consume such

14 beverages on the licensed premises. A person who violates this
15 subparagraph commits a misdemeanor of the second degree,
16 punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. A person who
17 violates this subparagraph a second or subsequent time within 1
18 year after a prior conviction commits a misdemeanor of the first
19 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

20 2. In addition to any other penalty imposed for a
21 violation of subparagraph 1., the court may order the Department
22 of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to withhold the issuance
23 of, or suspend or revoke, the driver license or driving
24 privilege, as provided in s. 322.057, of any person who violates
25 subparagraph 1. This subparagraph does not apply to a licensee,
26 as defined in s. 561.01, who violates subparagraph 1. while
27 acting within the scope of his or her license or an employee or
28 agent of a licensee, as defined in s. 561.01, who violates
29 subparagraph 1. while engaged within the scope of his or her
30 employment or agency.

31 3. A court that withholds the issuance of, or suspends or
32 revokes, the driver license or driving privilege of a person
33 pursuant to subparagraph 2. may direct the Department of Highway
34 Safety and Motor Vehicles to issue the person a license for
35 driving privilege restricted to business purposes only, as
36 defined in s. 322.271, if he or she is otherwise qualified.

37 4. A vendor licensed to sell alcoholic beverages under s.
38 563.02(1), s. 564.02(1)(a), or s. 565.02(1)(a) who sells
