Remove lines 27-38 and insert:

or brand registrant of malt beverage, or any sales agent or
 sales person thereof, provides a vendor licensed to sell malt
 beverages for on-premises consumption with expendable retailer
 advertising specialties such as trays, coasters, mats, menu
 cards, napkins, cups, glassware ~~glasses~~, thermometers, and the
 like, such items may be sold only at a price not less than the
 actual cost to the industry member who initially purchased them,
 without limitation in total dollar value of such items sold to a
 vendor. However, a distributor that has received single service
 branded glassware at no charge from its malt beverage

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17 manufacturer or importer may give such glassware to a vendor
18 licensed to sell malt beverages for on-premises consumption.
19 Each piece of glassware given to a vendor by a distributor shall
20 bear a permanent brand name intended to prominently advertise
21 the brand. The total pieces of glassware shall not exceed 3
22 cases advertising up to 3 malt beverage brands per manufacturer
23 or importer per calendar year per licensed premises. A case is
24 defined as a box with up to 24 pieces of glassware. A single
25 service piece of glassware is defined as a glass container which
26 can hold no more than 22 ounces of liquid volume. A vendor that
27 receives such glassware gift from a distributor may not sell the
28 glassware or return it to a distributor for cash, credit, or
29 replacement. Vendors may only use such glassware to serve the
30 corresponding malt beverage brand advertised on the glassware to
31 consumers located on its licensed premises.
