7 Section 2. Section 943.0586, Florida Statutes, is created  
8 to read:

9 943.0586 Administrative sealing of criminal history  
10 records.-

11 (1) The Criminal Justice Information Program shall  
12 administratively seal the criminal history records pertaining to  
13 an arrest or incident of alleged criminal activity of an adult  
14 charged with a felony, misdemeanor, or violation of a comparable  
15 rule or ordinance by a state, county, municipal, or other law  
16 enforcement agency upon notification by the clerk of the court,

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17 pursuant to s. 943.052(2), that all the charges related to the  
18 arrest or incident of alleged criminal activity were declined to  
19 be filed by the state attorney or statewide prosecutor or  
20 dismissed or nolle prosequi before trial, or resulted in a  
21 judgment of acquittal or verdict of not guilty at trial.

22 (2) The sealing under this section of a criminal history  
23 record has the same effect as a sealing under s. 943.059(4).

24 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
