7 (c)1. Funds provided to the authority by the department
8 under this subsection constitute state financial assistance
9 provided to a nonstate entity to carry out a state project
10 subject to ss. 215.97 and 215.971. The department shall provide
11 the funds in accordance with the terms of a written agreement to
12 be entered into between the authority and the department, which
13 shall provide for department review, approval, and audit of
14 authority expenditure of such funds and shall include such other
15 provisions as are required by applicable law. The department is
16 specifically authorized to agree to advance the authority 25

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17 percent of the total funds provided under this subsection for a
18 state fiscal year at the beginning of each state fiscal year,
19 with monthly payments over the fiscal year on a reimbursement
20 basis as supported by invoices and such additional documentation
21 and information as the department may reasonably require and a
22 reconciliation of the advance against remaining invoices in the
23 last quarter of the fiscal year ~~may not be committed by the~~
24 ~~authority without the approval of the department, which may not~~
25 ~~be unreasonably withheld. At least 90 days before advertising~~
26 ~~any procurement or renewing any existing contract that will rely~~
27 ~~on state funds for payment, the authority shall notify the~~
28 ~~department of the proposed procurement or renewal and the~~
29 ~~proposed terms thereof. If the department, within 60 days after~~
30 ~~receipt of notice, objects in writing to the proposed~~
