Amendment

Remove lines 49-65 and insert:

(11) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Florida Expressway Authority Act, no less than 20 percent of the annual surplus revenues as defined in s. 348.0002(12) of an authority in any county as defined in s. 125.011(1) shall be transferred to the county in which the authority operates on an annual basis within 45 days following the conclusion of the authority's fiscal year. Such transferred funds shall be used solely to finance, design, acquire right of way, pay project delivery costs, and construct new, or improvements or extensions to existing, public transportation facilities, transit facilities,

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17 intermodal facilities, or multimodal corridors owned, acquired
18 or operated by the county. The board of county commissioners of
19 such county shall approve any expenditure of transferred funds
20 by a majority vote of the commissioners present. Projects may
21 be implemented using a public private partnership or a design
22 build contract. Transferred funds may be considered as a local
23 match for any available federal or state funds for such
24 projects.

25 By December 1, 2017 and December 1 each year thereafter,
26 the county shall submit a report to the President of the Senate
27 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives which includes a
28 description of each project funded or to be funded, the proposed
29 budget, the proposed funding partners, and completion date for
30 each such project.
