2. Be tested for any condition included on the federal  
Recommended Uniform Screening Panel which the council advises  
the department should be included under the state's screening  
program. The department shall expand statewide screening of  
newborns to include screening for such conditions within 18  
months after the council renders such advice, if an FDA approved  
test, or an alternative vendor test, compatible with Florida lab  
standards is available. If an FDA approved test is not available  
within 18 months after the council makes its recommendation, the
