Section 15. Section 288.101, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

288.101 Florida Job Growth Grant Fund.-

(1) The Florida Job Growth Grant Fund is created within the department to promote economic opportunity by improving public infrastructure and enhancing workforce training. The Florida Job Growth Grant Fund may not be used for the exclusive benefit of Florida Senate - 2017 Bill No. HB 1-A
