 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
 8

9 Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 627.7011, Florida
 10 Statutes, is amended to read:

11 627.7011 Homeowners' policies; offer of replacement cost
 12 coverage and law and ordinance coverage.—

13 (4) An insurer that issues a homeowner's insurance policy
 14 must include with the policy documents at initial issuance and
 15 every renewal in bold type no smaller than 18 points the
 16 following statement:

17 "LAW AND ORDINANCE: LAW AND ORDINANCE COVERAGE IS AN IMPORTANT
 18 COVERAGE THAT YOU MAY WISH TO PURCHASE. PLEASE DISCUSS WITH YOUR
 19 INSURANCE AGENT."

20 "FLOOD INSURANCE: YOU MAY ALSO NEED TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF
 21 FLOOD INSURANCE FROM THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM. YOUR
 22 HOMEOWNER'S INSURANCE POLICY DOES NOT INCLUDE COVERAGE FOR
 23 DAMAGE RESULTING FROM FLOOD EVEN IF HURRICANE WINDS AND RAIN
 24 CAUSED THE FLOOD TO OCCUR. WITHOUT SEPARATE FLOOD INSURANCE THIS

26 | DISCUSS THE NEED TO PURCHASE SEPARATE FLOOD INSURANCE COVERAGE

28 | The intent of this subsection is to encourage policyholders to
29 | purchase sufficient coverage to protect them in case events
30 | excluded from the standard homeowners policy, such as law and
31 | ordinance enforcement and flood, combine with covered events to
32 | produce damage or loss to the insured property. The intent is
33 | also to encourage policyholders to discuss these issues with
34 | their insurance agent.

35 | Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2019.
