Each county shall constitute a school district; provided, two or more contiguous counties, upon vote of the

electors of each county pursuant to law, may be combined into one school district. In each school district there shall be a school board composed of five or more members chosen by vote of the electors in a nonpartisan election for appropriately staggered terms of four years, as provided by law.

- (b) The school board shall operate, control and supervise all free public schools within the school district and determine the rate of school district taxes within the limits prescribed herein. Two or more school districts may operate and finance joint educational programs.
- (c) A person may not appear on the ballot for re-election to the office of school board if, by the end of the current term of office, the person will have served, or but for resignation would have served, in that office for eight consecutive years.

  Service to the office of school board after 2013 accrues toward the limitations prescribed herein.
