4 Remove lines 955-1148 and insert:

5 (1) (a) The registration certificate or an official copy  
6 thereof, including an electronic copy in a format authorized by  
7 the department, a true copy or an electronic copy of rental or  
8 lease documentation issued for a motor vehicle or issued for a  
9 replacement vehicle in the same registration period, a temporary  
10 receipt printed upon self-initiated electronic renewal of a  
11 registration via the Internet, or a cab card issued for a  
12 vehicle registered under the International Registration Plan  
13 shall, at all times while the vehicle is being used or operated

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14 on the roads of this state, be in the possession of the operator  
15 thereof or be carried in the vehicle for which issued and shall  
16 be exhibited upon demand of any authorized law enforcement  
17 officer or any agent of the department, except for a vehicle  
18 registered under s. 320.0657. ~~The provisions of~~ This section  
19 does ~~de~~ not apply during the first 30 days after purchase of a  
20 replacement vehicle. A violation of this section is a  
21 noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a nonmoving  
22 violation as provided in chapter 318.

23 (b)1. The act of presenting to a law enforcement officer  
24 or agent of the department an electronic device displaying an  
25 electronic copy of the registration certificate or the rental or  
26 lease documentation does not constitute consent for the officer  
27 or agent to access any information on the device other than the  
28 displayed registration certificate or rental or lease  
29 documentation.

30 2. The person who presents the device to the officer or  
31 agent assumes the liability for any resulting damage to the  
32 device.

33 (2) Rental or lease documentation that is sufficient to  
34 satisfy the requirement in subsection (1) includes the  
35 following:

- 36 (a) ~~Date of rental~~ and time of ~~exit from rental facility~~;
- 37 (b) Rental station identification;
- 38 (c) Rental agreement number;

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- 39 (d) Rental vehicle identification number;  
40 (e) Rental vehicle license plate number and state of  
41 registration;  
42 (f) Vehicle's make, model, and color;  
43 (g) Vehicle's mileage; and  
44 (h) Authorized renter's name.

45 Section 18. Subsection (5) of section 320.0607, Florida  
46 Statutes, is amended to read:

47 320.0607 Replacement license plates, validation decal, or  
48 mobile home sticker.—

49 (5) Upon the issuance of an original license plate, the  
50 applicant shall pay a fee of \$28 to be deposited in the Highway  
51 Safety Operating Trust Fund. Beginning October 1, 2019, this  
52 subsection does not apply to a vehicle registered under the  
53 International Registration Plan.

54 Section 19. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section  
55 320.0657, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

56 320.0657 Permanent registration; fleet license plates.—

57 (2)

58 (b) The plates, which shall be of a distinctive color,  
59 shall have the word "Fleet" appearing at the bottom and the word  
60 "Florida" appearing at the top unless the license plate is a  
61 specialty license plate as authorized in s. 320.08056. The  
62 plates shall conform in all respects to the provisions of this  
63 chapter, except as specified herein. For additional fees as set

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64 forth in s. 320.08056, fleet companies may purchase specialty  
65 license plates in lieu of the standard fleet license plates.  
66 Fleet companies shall be responsible for all costs associated  
67 with the specialty license plate, including all annual use fees,  
68 processing fees, fees associated with switching license plate  
69 types, and any other applicable fees.

70 Section 20. Subsection (12) of section 320.08, Florida  
71 Statutes, is amended to read:

72 320.08 License taxes.—Except as otherwise provided herein,  
73 there are hereby levied and imposed annual license taxes for the  
74 operation of motor vehicles, mopeds, motorized bicycles as  
75 defined in s. 316.003(3), tri-vehicles as defined in s. 316.003,  
76 and mobile homes as defined in s. 320.01, which shall be paid to  
77 and collected by the department or its agent upon the  
78 registration or renewal of registration of the following:

79 (12) DEALER AND MANUFACTURER LICENSE PLATES.—A franchised  
80 motor vehicle dealer, independent motor vehicle dealer, marine  
81 boat trailer dealer, or mobile home dealer and manufacturer  
82 license plate: \$17 flat, of which \$4.50 shall be deposited into  
83 the General Revenue Fund. For additional fees as set forth in s.  
84 320.08056, dealers may purchase specialty license plates in lieu  
85 of the standard graphic dealer license plates. Dealers shall be  
86 responsible for all costs associated with the specialty license  
87 plate, including all annual use fees, processing fees, fees

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88 associated with switching license plate types, and any other  
89 applicable fees.

90 Section 21. Subsection (2) of section 320.08056, Florida  
91 Statutes, is amended, and paragraphs (ffff) and (gggg) are added  
92 to subsection (4) of that section, to read:

93 320.08056 Specialty license plates.-

94 (2)(a) The department shall issue a specialty license  
95 plate to the owner or lessee of any motor vehicle, except a  
96 vehicle registered under the International Registration Plan, a  
97 commercial truck required to display two license plates pursuant  
98 to s. 320.0706, or a truck tractor, upon request and payment of  
99 the appropriate license tax and fees.

100 (b) The department may authorize dealer and fleet  
101 specialty license plates. With the permission of the sponsoring  
102 specialty license plate organization, a dealer or fleet company  
103 may purchase specialty license plates to be used on dealer and  
104 fleet vehicles.

105 (c) Notwithstanding s. 320.08058, a dealer or fleet  
106 specialty license plate must include the letters "DLR" or "FLT"  
107 on the right side of the license plate. Dealer and fleet  
108 specialty license plates must be ordered directly through the  
109 department.

110 (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be  
111 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

112 (ffff) Orlando City Soccer Club license plate, \$25.

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113        (gggg) Orlando United license plate, \$25.  
114        Section 22. Subsections (84) and (85) are added to section  
115 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:  
116        320.08058 Specialty license plates.—  
117        (84) ORLANDO CITY SOCCER CLUB LICENSE PLATES.—  
118        (a) The department shall develop an Orlando City Soccer  
119 Club license plate as provided in paragraph (9) (a).  
120        (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall  
121 be distributed and used as provided in paragraph (9) (b).  
122        (85) ORLANDO UNITED LICENSE PLATES.—  
123        (a) The department shall develop an Orlando United license  
124 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate  
125 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The  
126 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the  
127 words "Orlando United" must appear at the bottom of the plate.  
128        (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall  
129 be distributed as follows:  
130        1. Seven percent shall be distributed to the Mental Health  
131 Association of Central Florida, Inc., to be used for marketing  
132 of the license plate.  
133        2. Thirty-one percent shall be distributed to the Mental  
134 Health Association of Central Florida, Inc. Of this amount, up  
135 to 5 percent may be used for administrative expenses, and the  
136 remainder shall be used to offer free personalized counseling to

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137 any person affected by the shooting at the Pulse nightclub in  
138 Orlando on June 12, 2016.

139 3. Thirty-one percent shall be distributed to onePULSE  
140 Foundation, a charitable, nonprofit organization under s.  
141 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Of this amount, up to 5  
142 percent may be used for administrative expenses, and the  
143 remainder shall be used to support the construction and  
144 maintenance of the onePULSE Foundation Memorial.

145 4. Thirty-one percent shall be distributed to Two Spirit  
146 Health Services, Inc. Of this amount, up to 5 percent may be  
147 used for administrative expenses, and the remainder shall be  
148 used to offer free personalized counseling to any person  
149 affected by the shooting at the Pulse nightclub in Orlando on  
150 June 12, 2016.

151 Section 23. Subsection (10) is added to section 320.131,  
152 Florida Statutes, to read:

153 320.131 Temporary tags.—

154 (10) Beginning October 1, 2018, the department may partner  
155 with a county tax collector to conduct a Fleet Vehicle Temporary  
156 Tag pilot program to provide temporary tags to fleet companies  
157 to allow them to operate fleet vehicles awaiting a permanent  
158 registration and title.

159 (a) The department shall establish a memorandum of  
160 understanding that allows a maximum of three companies to

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161 participate in the pilot program and receive multiple temporary  
162 tags for company fleet vehicles.

163 (b) To participate in the program, a fleet company must  
164 have a minimum of 3,500 fleet vehicles registered in this state  
165 which qualify to be registered as fleet vehicles pursuant to s.  
166 320.0657.

167 (c) The department may issue up to 50 temporary tags at a  
168 time to an eligible fleet company, if requested by such company.

169 (d) The temporary tags are for exclusive use on a vehicle  
170 purchased for the company's fleet, and may not be used on any  
171 other vehicle.

172 (e) Each temporary plate may be used on only one vehicle  
173 and each vehicle may only use one temporary plate.

174 (f) Upon issuance of the vehicle's permanent license plate  
175 and registration, the temporary tag becomes invalid and must be  
176 removed from the vehicle and destroyed.

177 (g) Upon a finding by the department that a temporary tag  
178 has been misused by a fleet company under this program, the  
179 department may terminate the memorandum of understanding with  
180 the company, invalidate all temporary tags issued to the company  
181 under the program, and require such company to return any unused  
182 temporary tags.

183 (h) This subsection is repealed on October 1, 2021, unless  
184 saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

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185 Section 24. Subsection (3) is added to section 320.95,  
186 Florida Statutes, to read:

187 320.95 Transactions by electronic or telephonic means.—

188 (3) The department may authorize issuance of an electronic  
189 certificate of registration in addition to printing a paper  
190 registration certificate. A motor vehicle operator may present  
191 for inspection an electronic device displaying an electronic  
192 certificate of registration issued pursuant to this subsection  
193 in lieu of a paper registration certificate. Such presentation  
194 does not constitute consent for inspection of any information on  
195 the device other than the displayed certificate of registration.  
196 The person who presents the device for inspection assumes the  
197 liability for any resulting damage to the device.
