authorized to reimburse, retroactive to January 1, 1987, up to \$1,000 in nonrecurring expenses related to the adoption of a child which have been incurred by adoptive parents. For purposes of this subsection, "nonrecurring expenses" means one-time expenses, such as <u>attorney fees</u> attorney's fees, court costs, birth certificate fees, travel expenses, agency fees, and physical examination fees.
