(48) LIVE THE DREAM LICENSE PLATES.-

(a) The department shall develop a Live the Dream license
plate as provided in this section. Live the Dream license plates
must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
words "Live the Dream" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

39 (b) The proceeds of the annual use fee shall be distributed 40 to the Dream Foundation, Inc., to The Dream Foundation, Inc., shall retain the first \$60,000 in proceeds from the annual use 41 42 fees as reimbursement for administrative costs, startup costs, and costs incurred in the approval process.
