Such technologies 22 23 and processes must include, without limitation, video billing and variable pricing. The Florida Turnpike Enterprise may 24 25 require the use of an electronic transponder interoperable with 26 the department's electronic toll collection system for the use 27 of express lanes on the turnpike system. Variable pricing may 28 not be implemented in express lanes when the level of service in 29 the express lane, determined in accordance with the criteria 30 established by the Transportation Research Board Highway 31 Capacity Manual (5th Edition, HCM 2010), as amended from time to 32 time, is equal to level of service A.
