39 a semitrailer combination wherein the fifth wheel is located on a drop frame located behind and below the rearmost axle of the 40 41 power unit. Automobile transporters operating under this 42 subsection may backhaul cargo or general freight when the weight 43 limits of s. 316.535 are not exceeded. (b) Semitrailers.-

70 1. A semitrailer operating in a truck tractor-semitrailer 71 combination may not exceed 48 feet in extreme overall outside dimension, measured from the front of the unit to the rear of 72 73 the unit and the load carried thereon, exclusive of safety and 74 energy conservation devices approved by the department for use 75 on vehicles using public roads, unless it complies with 76 subparagraph 2. A semitrailer which exceeds 48 feet in length 77 and is used to transport divisible loads may operate in this 78 state only if issued a permit under s. 316.550 and if such 79 trailer meets the requirements of this chapter relating to 80 vehicle equipment and safety. (4) LOAD EXTENSION LIMITATION.—The load upon any vehicle operated alone, or the load upon the front vehicle of a combination of vehicles, may not extend more than 3 feet beyond the front wheels of the vehicle or the front bumper of the vehicle if it is equipped with a bumper. <u>However, the load upon</u> <u>any stinger-steered automobile transporter may not extend more</u> than 4 feet beyond the front bumper of the vehicle.
