Between lines 1480 and 1481

insert:

Section 44. Subsection (2) of section 633.314, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

633.314 Sale or use of certain types of fire extinguishers prohibited; penalty.—

(2) It is unlawful for any person, directly or through an agent, to sell, offer for sale, or give in this state any make,



11 type, or model of fire extinguisher, either new or used, unless  
12 such make, type, or model of extinguisher has first been tested  
13 and is currently approved or listed by Underwriters  
14 Laboratories, Inc., Factory Mutual Laboratories, Inc., or  
15 another testing laboratory recognized by the State Fire Marshal  
16 as nationally recognized in accordance with procedures adopted  
17 by rule, taking into account the laboratory's facilities,  
18 procedures, use of nationally recognized standards, and any  
19 other criteria reasonably calculated to reach an informed  
20 determination, and unless such extinguisher carries an  
21 Underwriters Laboratories, Inc., or manufacturer's serial  
22 number. Such serial number must ~~shall~~ be permanently affixed  
23 ~~stamped~~ on the manufacturer's identification and instruction  
24 plate.
