2 An act relating to Duval County; providing an
3 exception to general law; providing requirements for
4 high school students to be promoted and to graduate;
5 providing an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
8

9 Section 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other law to the
10 contrary, Duval County Public School high school students and
11 their parents or guardians must attend annual Individual Student
12 Evaluation sessions in grades 9, 10, and 11 to review a
13 student's academic status for on-time graduation.

14 (2) The student and his or her parent or guardian shall
15 meet with the guidance counselor before the third grading period
16 of the school year begins. An Education Forecast of the
17 student's graduation needs will be examined and an official plan
18 agreed upon. Students will not be promoted to the next grade
19 level without an Individual Student Evaluation approved by a
20 parent or guardian and a guidance counselor.

21 (3) An official notice of Individual Student Evaluation
22 Sessions must be provided to students on the first day of school
23 to be signed by a parent or guardian and returned within 5
24 school days. A list of all students without signed notices will

25 | be turned in to school administration by the 15th school day for
26 | guidance tracking purposes.

27 | (4) A list of students who are not eligible for promotion
28 | to the next grade and a list of students who are not eligible
29 | for graduation will be available at the guidance counselor's
30 | office for parents and guardians to review. Students will be
31 | given an opportunity to be cleared from the list by completing
32 | the Individual Student Evaluation requirements.

33 | Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
