## **I.Amendments Contained in Message:**

**House Amendment 1 – 516173** (body with title)

## **II.Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:**

**House Amendment 1** removes Section 15 of the bill, amending s. 985.557(1), F.S., related to discretionary direct file.

Current law provides that the minimum age in which a child can be transferred to adult court pursuant to discretionary direct file is 14. Section 15 of the bill proposed to raise the minimum age in which a child could be transferred to adult court pursuant to discretionary direct file from 14 to 15. The amendment removes this provision to maintain current law.
