**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 127-145 and insert:

(5) LIMITATION ON ACTIONS.- A cause of action under this section may not be brought against a licensee under part I of chapter 509.

Section 3. Section 509.210, Florida Statutes, is created read:

509.210. Training of public food service and lodging establishment employees regarding human trafficking.-

(1) The division shall adopt by rule, in consultation with the Attorney General and state and national restaurant and lodging associations, at least one educational program to train employees of public food service and lodging establishments to

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17 identify and report suspected human trafficking activity. The  
18 operator of a public food service or lodging establishment may  
19 also adopt its own educational program for this purpose, which  
20 must be submitted to the division for approval. The division  
21 must approve such a program if it is determined to be as  
22 comprehensive and effective as similar programs approved by the  
23 division. The division shall adopt rules requiring the operator  
24 of each public food service or lodging establishment to train  
25 any employee reasonably expected to routinely interact with  
26 guests, within a reasonable period of time after hiring, and at  
27 appropriate intervals thereafter, and to maintain documentation  
28 of such training for inspection. The division shall impose  
29 administrative sanctions pursuant to s. 509.261 against an  
30 operator who fails to comply with the rule.

31 (2) Upon request, public food service and lodging  
32 establishments must provide the division with proof of employee  
33 training as required herein, including at the time of a division  
34 inspection of the establishment. Proof of training shall include  
35 the name, date of birth, and job title of the trained employee;  
36 the date the training occurred; and the approved educational  
37 program used in training.

38 (3) The division may adopt emergency rules pursuant to s.  
39 120.54 to implement this section. The Legislature finds  
40 emergency rulemaking power necessary for the preservation of the  
41 rights and welfare of the people of Florida and to address the

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42 scourge of human trafficking in our state. The adoption of  
43 emergency rules are exempt from s. 120.54(4)(a).
