A bill to be entitled

An act relating to patriotic societies; providing a short title; creating s. 1001.433, F.S.; defining the term "patriotic society"; requiring district school boards to allow specified representatives an opportunity to speak to students for certain purposes; requiring a patriotic society and school principal to provide certain information in writing within specified time periods; providing that a patriotic society's presentation may not exceed a specified time; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Scouts Access Bill."

1001.433 Patriotic societies in schools.-

(1) As used in this section, "patriotic society" means a youth group listed in Title 36, U.S.C., as a patriotic society, including the Boy Scouts of America, and its affiliated Florida groups and councils, and the Girl Scouts of the United States of America, and its affiliated Florida groups and councils.

Section 2. Section 1001.433, Florida Statutes, is created

(2) A district school board must allow a representative of a patriotic society the opportunity, during school hours, to speak with and distribute instructional materials to students to encourage participation in the patriotic society and its activities.

(3) (a) A patriotic society shall provide at least 60 days' written notice to the school district and principal of the school of its intent to speak to students. Within 15 days after receipt of the notice, the principal must provide in writing to the patriotic society a specific day and time within the next 45 school days for the patriotic society's representative to speak to students.

(b) A patriotic society's presentation to students may not exceed 10 minutes of instructional time.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
