16	(a) The commission shall be composed of seven residents of

18	the Senate. In making appointments, the Governor shall provide
19	reasonable representation from all sections of the state.
20	Membership shall be representative of agriculture, the
21	development industry, local government, the environmental
22	community, lay citizens, and members of the scientific and
23	technical community who have substantial expertise in the areas
24	of the fate and transport of water pollutants, toxicology,
25	epidemiology, geology, biology, environmental sciences, or
26	engineering.
27	(b) The Governor shall, within 90 days after the occurrence
28	of a vacancy on the commission, appoint a new member, subject to
29	confirmation by the Senate.
