8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

10 Section 1. Paragraphs (d) and (e) are added to subsection
11 (1) of section 327.4108, Florida Statutes, to read:

12 327.4108 Anchoring of vessels in anchoring limitation
13 areas.—

14 (1) The following densely populated urban areas, which have
15 narrow state waterways, residential docking facilities, and
16 significant recreational boating traffic, are designated as
17 anchoring limitation areas:

18 (d) The body of water commonly known as North Lake, located
19 in Broward County on the west side of the Intracoastal Waterway
20 approximately one-quarter mile north of Hollywood Boulevard.

21 (e) The body of water commonly known as South Lake, located
22 in Broward County on the west side of the Intracoastal Waterway
23 approximately one-quarter mile south of Hollywood Boulevard.

24 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
