17	(12) Prior to the transplant of an organ <u>or an allograft</u>
18	or artificial insemination, the institution or physician
19	responsible for overseeing the procedure must provide the
20	prospective recipient a warning as to the risks of contracting
21	human immunodeficiency virus and the Zika virus. The Zika virus
22	warning is not required for an organ or an allograft that has
23	been virally inactivated. For the purpose of this subsection,
24	the term:
25	(a) "Allograft" means human cells, tissues, or cellular or

27 (b) "Virally inactivated" means a validated process that
28 <u>eliminates viral contamination in an organ or allograft.</u>
29 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.

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
