Senate Amendment

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Delete lines 89 - 91

and insert:

(h) Ensure that all employees and volunteers of a provider provide only medically accurate information to clients, including, but not limited to, information on family planning, birth control, sexually transmitted diseases, pregnancy, abortion, labor and delivery, and postpartum care. Such information must be:

1. Verified or supported by the weight of medical research

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conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods; 2. Recognized as correct and objective by leading medical organizations with relevant expertise, such as the American Medical Association, the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the American Public Health Association, the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American College of Physicians, and the American Academy of Family Physicians; or by government agencies such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the federal Food and Drug Administration, the National Cancer Institute, the American Psychological Association, and the National Institutes of Health; or 3. Recommended by or affirmed in the medical practice quidelines of a nationally recognized accrediting organization, such as the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations, the National Committee for Quality Assurance, the American Medical Accreditation Program, the American Accreditation HealthCare Commission/Utilization Review Accreditation Commission, and the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care.
