21	of developing low self-esteem, an eating disorder, and a desire
22	to engage in risky sexual behavior, and
23	WHEREAS, pornography objectifies men and women, normalizes
24	violence and the abuse of men, women, and children, and depicts
25	rape and abuse as harmless, thereby increasing the demand for
26	sex trafficking, prostitution, and child pornography, and
27	WHEREAS, pornography has potential detrimental effects on
28	the user, including, but not limited to, mental and physical
29	illnesses; difficulty forming or maintaining intimate
