2018 Legislature

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An act relating to missing persons; amending s. 683.231, F.S.; making technical changes; abrogating the scheduled repeal of provisions governing the citizen support organization for Florida Missing Children's Day; amending s. 937.041, F.S.; expanding a project for missing persons with special needs to all centers for autism and related disabilities at state universities; revising requirements for personal devices used in the project; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (6) and subsections (7) and (8) of section 683.231, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

683.231 Citizen support organization for Florida Missing Children's Day.—

(6)

(c) The department may not authorize ~~permit~~ the use of any administrative services, property, or facilities of the state by a citizen support organization that does not provide equal membership and employment opportunities to all persons regardless of race, color, religion, gender, age, or national

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26 origin.

27 (7) The citizen support organization shall provide for an
 28 independent annual financial audit in accordance with s.
 29 215.981. Copies of the audit shall be provided to the
 30 department, the Office of Policy and Budget in the Executive
 31 Office of the Governor, and the ~~Florida~~ Cabinet.

 40 known as "Project Leo," through a center for autism and related
 41 disabilities established under section 1004.55. Each center that
 42 opts to join the project shall distribute ~~to provide~~ personal
 43 devices to aid search-and-rescue efforts for persons with
 44 special needs in the case of elopement.

 74 search-and-rescue efforts ~~which are attachable to clothing or~~
 75 ~~otherwise worn~~ shall be provided by the respective center to the

77 | shall be distributed to project participants by the county
78 | sheriff's offices in conjunction with the respective center. The
79 | respective center shall fund any costs associated with
80 | monitoring the devices.

81 | ~~(4) Each center shall submit a preliminary report by~~
82 | ~~December 1, 2016, and a final report by December 15, 2017, to~~
83 | ~~the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of~~
84 | ~~the House of Representatives describing the implementation and~~
85 | ~~operation of its pilot project. At a minimum, each report must~~
86 | ~~include the criteria used to select participants, the number of~~
87 | ~~participants, the nature of the participants' special needs, the~~
88 | ~~number of participants who elope, the amount of time taken to~~

90 | ~~any rescue attempts. Each final report shall also provide~~
