7 (19) ~~It is not the obligation of Aa~~ nurse registry may not  
 8 ~~to~~ monitor, supervise, manage, or train a registered nurse,  
 9 licensed practical nurse, certified nursing assistant, companion  
 10 or homemaker, or home health aide referred for contract under  
 11 this chapter. In the event of a violation of this chapter or a  
 12 violation of any other law of this state by a referred  
 13 registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, certified nursing  
 14 assistant, companion or homemaker, or home health aide, or a  
 15 deficiency in credentials which comes to the attention of the  
 16 nurse registry, the nurse registry shall advise the patient to

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17 terminate the referred person's contract, providing the reason  
18 for the suggested termination; cease referring the person to  
19 other patients or facilities; and, if practice violations are  
20 involved, notify the licensing board. This section does not  
21 affect or negate any other obligations imposed on a nurse  
22 registry under chapter 408.
