(c) A person who is receiving public assistance as defined 36 37 in s. 409.2554. (d) A person whose household income is below 130 percent 38 39 of the federal poverty level based on the current year's federal 40 poverty guidelines. 41 (2) A person must complete and sign, under penalty of 42 perjury, a Request for Fee Exemption to be furnished by the 43 local governing authority and provide written documentation in 44 support of his or her request for an exemption under subsection 45 (1). 46 (3) If a person who is exempt under subsection (1) owns a 47 majority interest in a business with fewer than 100 employees, the business is exempt. Such person must complete and sign, 48 49 under penalty of perjury, a Request for Fee Exemption to be 50 furnished by the local governing authority and provide written
