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**Amendment**

Remove lines 35-47 and insert:

(c) A maternal patient experiencing hemorrhagic shock or  
requiring a transfusion of more than 4 units of blood or blood  
products;

(d) A fetal or newborn death, including a stillbirth,  
associated with an obstetrical delivery;

(e) A transfer of a newborn to a neonatal intensive care  
unit due to a traumatic physical or neurological birth injury,  
including any degree of a brachial plexus injury;

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15           (f) A transfer of a newborn to a neonatal intensive care  
16 unit within the first 72 hours after birth if the newborn  
17 remains in such unit for more than 72 hours; or

18           (g) Any other injury as determined by department rule.

19           (2) Beginning July 1, 2018, a physician licensed under  
20 chapter 458 or chapter 459,
