18	including demographic and income disparities.
19	(b) Develop and evaluate policy proposals to address
20	barriers to care, expedience of care delivery, and oral health
21	outcomes for high-need and high-risk populations. Policy
22	proposals must be peer-reviewed and address evidence of clinical
23	outcomes and measures for increasing access to dental care for
24	unserved or underserved populations.
25	(c) Examine workforce policies authorizing or increasing

27	function dental assistants, community dental health
28	coordinators, and dental therapists.
29	(2) The department shall submit a report on the findings
30	of the study that includes recommendations on improving the
31	affordability, access, and delivery of dental care in this state
32	to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of
33	the House of Representatives by December 31, 2018. The report
34	must address any implementation burdens and the sustainability
35	of each policy recommendation.
36	(3) This act shall expire on January 31, 2019.
