The Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security (Farmer) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. (1) The Florida Strategic Fuel Reserve Task Force, a task force as defined in s. 20.03, Florida Statutes, is created within the Division of Emergency Management within the Executive Office of the Governor to develop a recommended strategic fuel reserve plan for the state to respond to private and public fuel needs in the event of an emergency or disaster,

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as defined in s. 252.34, Florida Statutes.
(2) The division shall provide administrative and support
services relating to the functions of the task force.
(3) The task force shall consist of the following members:
(a) Three persons appointed by the President of the Senate.
(b) Three persons appointed by the Speaker of the House of
Representatives.
(c) Three persons appointed by the Governor.
(4) The task force shall elect a chair and vice chair.
(5) The task force shall submit a recommended strategic
fuel reserve plan to the Governor, the President of the Senate,
and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by April 30,
<u>2019.</u>
(6) This section expires on June 30, 2019.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
