Between lines 647 and 648, insert:

Section 10. Paragraph (a) of subsection (12) of section 790.06, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

(12) (a) A license issued under this section does not authorize any person to openly carry a handgun or carry a concealed weapon or firearm into:

1. Any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05;
2. Any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station;
3. Any detention facility, prison, or jail;

14 4. Any courthouse or primary county administration
15 building not located within the courthouse;

16 5. Any courtroom, except that nothing in this section
17 would preclude a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or
18 determining who will carry a concealed weapon in his or her
19 courtroom;

20 6. Any polling place;

21 7. Any meeting of the governing body of a county, public
22 school district, municipality, or special district;

23 8. Any meeting of the Legislature or a committee thereof;

24 9. Any school, college, or professional athletic event not
25 related to firearms;

26 10. Any elementary or secondary school facility or
27 administration building;

28 11. Any career center;

29 12. Any portion of an establishment licensed to dispense
30 alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, which
31 portion of the establishment is primarily devoted to such
32 purpose;

33 13. Any college or university facility unless the licensee
34 is a registered student, employee, or faculty member of such
35 college or university and the weapon is a stun gun or nonlethal
36 electric weapon or device designed solely for defensive purposes
37 and the weapon does not fire a dart or projectile;
