Remove lines 2171-2184 and insert:

(a) Within 24-hours after receipt of the report of an incident involving a public school student as listed in subsection (3), the school principal shall provide a copy of the report to the parent and investigate the incident to determine if the incident must be reported as required by s. 1006.09(6). Upon conclusion of the investigation or within 15 days after the incident was reported, whichever occurs first, the school district shall notify the student's parent of the program and offer that parent an opportunity to enroll his or her student in

15 attend an eligible private school. A parent who chooses to
