- (d) "Business-funded trust" means an amount of financial aid provided by an eligible business when the business makes an eligible contribution.
- (2) An eligible business may apply to the department for a tax credit under this section. An eligible business is allowed a credit against the state tax imposed under this chapter in an amount equal to each business-funded trust created by the eligible business.
- (3) (a) The eligible business shall specify in the application the applicable fiscal year in which to apply the credit. The department shall approve tax credits on a first-come, first-served basis.
- (b) Within 10 days after approving or denying an application, the department shall provide a copy of its approval or denial letter to the eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization that was named by the eligible business in the application.
- (4) An eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization that receives eligible contributions pursuant to this section shall provide the eligible business with a receipt of the total amount of funds received from and the number of law enforcement officer positions funded by the eligible business. The eligible business shall provide this information to the department pursuant to s. 212.11(5).
