13 (d) "Business-funded trust" means an amount of financial
14 aid provided by an eligible business when the business makes an
15 eligible contribution.

16 (2) An eligible business may apply to the department for a
17 tax credit under this section. An eligible business is allowed a
18 credit against the state tax imposed under this chapter in an
19 amount equal to each business-funded trust created by the
20 eligible business.

21 (3) (a) The eligible business shall specify in the
22 application the applicable fiscal year in which to apply the
23 credit. The department shall approve tax credits on a first-
24 come, first-served basis.

25 (b) Within 10 days after approving or denying an
26 application, the department shall provide a copy of its approval
27 or denial letter to the eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding
28 organization that was named by the eligible business in the
29 application.

30 (4) An eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization
31 that receives eligible contributions pursuant to this section
32 shall provide the eligible business with a receipt of the total
33 amount of funds received from and the number of law enforcement
34 officer positions funded by the eligible business. The eligible
35 business shall provide this information to the department
36 pursuant to s. 212.11(5).

38 law enforcement officers within school districts if funds
39 appropriated in a state fiscal year are insufficient to fund
40 school law enforcement officers.

43 during any state fiscal year to fund school law enforcement
