Out-of-state residents must also submit a complete 68 set of fingerprints and fingerprint processing fee. The license 69 shall be renewed upon receipt of the completed renewal form, 70 color photograph, appropriate payment of fees, and, if applicable, fingerprints. Additionally, a licensee who fails to 71 file a renewal application on or before its expiration date must 72 73 renew his or her license by paying a late fee of \$15.
