A bill to be entitled

An act relating to a motor vehicle insurance online verification system; creating s. 324.252, F.S.; requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to establish an online verification system for motor vehicle insurance; specifying requirements for the system; requiring the department to conduct a pilot program to test the system; authorizing the department to contract with a private vendor for a specified purpose; requiring the system to be installed and operational by a specified date; authorizing law enforcement officers to access information from the system for specified purposes; specifying requirements for insurers; requiring the department to adopt rules; amending s. 320.02, F.S.; providing requirements relating to the registration of motor vehicles upon implementation of the system; amending s. 324.0221, F.S.; requiring the department to implement by rule a method of insurance verification using the system under certain circumstances; requiring the system to provide certain procedures; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 324.252, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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324.252 Motor vehicle insurance online verification system.—

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(1) The department shall establish an online verification system for motor vehicle insurance, subject to the following:

- (a) The verification system must be accessible through the Internet by authorized personnel of the department, the courts, law enforcement personnel, any other entities authorized by the department, and insurers authorized by the Office of Insurance Regulation to offer motor vehicle insurance.
- (b) The verification system must provide for direct access to insurers' records by personnel authorized by the department.
- (c) The department must conduct a pilot program to test the verification system before statewide use. However, the verification system must be installed and operational by July 1, 2020.
- (d) The verification system must be available 24 hours a day to verify the insurance status of any vehicle registered in this state through the vehicle identification number, policy number, registered owner's name, or other identifying characteristic or marker as prescribed by the department.
- (e) The department may contract with a private vendor to assist in establishing and maintaining the verification system.
- (f) The verification system must include appropriate provisions, consistent with industry standards, to secure its data against unauthorized access and to maintain a record of all information requests.
- (g) Information contained in the verification system which is otherwise exempt from public disclosure remains confidential or exempt from s. 119.07(1) and remains exempt from public disclosure.
 - (h) A law enforcement officer may, during a traffic stop or

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accident investigation, access information from the verification system to establish compliance with this chapter and to verify the current validity of the policy described on any insurance identification card produced by the operator of a motor vehicle during the traffic stop or accident investigation.

- (2) Insurers shall cooperate with the department in establishing and maintaining the verification system and shall provide access to motor vehicle insurance policy status information.
- (3) The department shall adopt rules to administer this section.

Section 2. Paragraph (f) is added to subsection (5) of section 320.02, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.02 Registration required; application for registration; forms.—

(5)

in s. 324.252, the online verification replaces the procedures in this subsection, and each registering agency shall use the system unless the system is not online or the required information is not available. In such a case, the registering agency may accept verification as provided in this subsection to certify the existence of the required insurance before processing any application for motor vehicle registration.

Section 3. Subsection (4) is added to section 324.0221, Florida Statutes, to read:

324.0221 Reports by insurers to the department; suspension of driver license and vehicle registrations; reinstatement.—

(4) The department shall implement by rule a method of

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insurance verification using the system in s. 324.252, which

must be a method of determining verification after the insurance

verification provided at the time of registration of the

vehicle, after reinstatement for a suspension for a violation of

this chapter, or if the department believes an owner or operator

of a motor vehicle is not in compliance with this chapter. The

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
