House Resolution

A resolution designating February 6, 2018, as "FSU Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, the Tallahassee campus of Florida State University (FSU), founded in 1851, is the oldest continuous site of higher education in Florida, and

WHEREAS, FSU is proud to be recognized as a preeminent state research university by the State of Florida and as a leader in education, research, student retention, and graduation, and

WHEREAS, FSU is a nationally recognized institution with many of its colleges and programs ranked in the top ten in the nation, and

WHEREAS, in 2017, FSU rose to number 33 in the U.S. News and World Report rankings for best public universities, significantly moving up the list for the second consecutive year, and

WHEREAS, U.S. News and World Report also recognized FSU as the second most efficient university in the nation for the sixth consecutive year, a title earned by the university through managing its financial resources responsibly in addition to providing a top-quality education, and

WHEREAS, FSU offers graduate, undergraduate, doctoral, and professional degrees in 351 programs within 16 independent

colleges and schools that are led by a faculty of 2,360 members, which has included six Nobel Laureates and members of the National Academy of Sciences, and

WHEREAS, FSU is more popular than ever among prospective first-time college students with a total of 42,325 applications received for admission to the 2017 summer and fall semesters, a record high and a 16 percent increase over 2016, and

WHEREAS, the 2017 freshman class at FSU is one of the university's largest and most academically accomplished freshman classes in university history, totaling approximately 6,500 students, with an average incoming GPA of 4.1 and a median SAT score of 1289, and

WHEREAS, FSU's four-year graduation rate of 65 percent is one of the top 20 rates in the nation amongst public research institutions, and

WHEREAS, the veteran-empowering programs and heritage at FSU make the university a national beacon of veteran support and success, and the welcoming campus culture at the university facilitates veterans' integration into the general student population, and

WHEREAS, veterans and current members of the U.S. military graduate from FSU at nearly twice the national average, and

WHEREAS, student veterans and veteran alumni from FSU assume leadership positions during their time on campus and in their careers, and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the FSU College of Medicine surpassed more than \$100 million in funded research for the first time, contributing to a statewide economic impact measured at more than \$100 million, and

WHEREAS, more than 300 College of Medicine alumni physicians now practice in Florida with many serving in medically underserved communities that previously struggled to recruit new doctors, and

WHEREAS, the college experience continues to enrich the lives of FSU students due to the long-standing tradition of promoting racial, ethnic, and cultural diversity on its campus along with the active recruitment of diverse groups of students, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That February 6, 2018, is designated as "FSU Day" in Florida in recognition of Florida State University's contributions as an outstanding institution of higher education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be presented to President John Thrasher of Florida State University as a tangible token of the sentiments expressed herein.
