House Resolution

A resolution recognizing July 2018 as "Peruvian Heritage Month" in Florida.

WHEREAS, Peru has a deep and rich heritage and is the home of ancient cultures spanning from the Norte Chico civilization in Caral, one of the oldest civilizations in the world, to the Inca Empire, the largest state in Pre-Columbian America, and

WHEREAS, the Peruvian landscape is vibrant and varied, featuring arid plains, the Andes Mountains, the tropical Amazon Basin rainforest, and the Amazon River, and has influenced and inspired the Peruvian history and culture, including the many Peruvian Americans who have brought their talents and history to this great state and nation, and

WHEREAS, counted among the many influential sons and daughters of Peru are the fifth Secretary-General of the United Nations, Javier Felipe Ricardo Pérez de Cuéllar Guerra; World War II hero, Arthur Chin; artist and activist, Favianna Rodriguez; American astronaut, Carlos Noriega; composer, Daniel Alomia Robles; singer, Yma Sumac; economist, Hernando de Soto Polar; actor and advocate, Q'orianka Kilcher; Chef, Emmanuel Piqueras; sportsman, Alex Olmedo; and writer and journalist, Daniel Alarcon, and

WHEREAS, Florida is home to the largest Peruvian population in the country and as educators, authors, community leaders,
