6 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

7 Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 98.075, Florida

8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 98.075 Registration records maintenance activities;

10 ineligibility determinations.-

11 (2) DUPLICATE REGISTRATION.-

12 (a) The department shall identify those voters who are  
 13 registered more than once within the state or those applicants  
 14 whose registration applications within the state would result in  
 15 duplicate registrations. The most recent application shall be  
 16 deemed an update to the voter registration record.

17        (b)1. The department may become a member of a  
18 nongovernmental entity whose membership is composed solely of  
19 election officials of state governments and the District of  
20 Columbia if the sole purpose of the membership is to share and  
21 exchange information in order to verify voter registration  
22 information. If the department intends to become a member of  
23 such a nongovernmental entity, the agreement to join the entity  
24 must require that the Secretary of State, or his or her  
25 designee, serve as a full member with voting rights on the  
26 nongovernmental entity's board of directors within 12 months  
27 after joining the entity.

28        2. The department may share confidential and exempt  
29 information after becoming a member of a nongovernmental entity  
30 as provided in subparagraph 1. if:

31        a. Each member of the nongovernmental entity agrees to  
32 maintain the confidentiality of such information as required by  
33 the laws of the jurisdiction providing the information; or

34        b. The bylaws of the nongovernmental entity require member  
35 jurisdictions and the entity to maintain the confidentiality of  
36 information as required by the laws of the jurisdiction  
37 providing the information.

38        3. The department may only become a member of a  
39 nongovernmental entity as provided in subparagraph 1. if the  
40 entity is controlled and operated by the participating  
41 jurisdictions. The entity may not be operated or controlled by

42 the Federal Government or any other entity acting on behalf of  
43 the Federal Government. The department must be able to withdraw  
44 at any time from any such membership entered into.

45 4. If the department becomes a member of a nongovernmental  
46 entity as provided in subparagraph 1., the Department of Highway  
47 Safety and Motor Vehicles must, pursuant to a written agreement  
48 with the department, provide driver license or identification  
49 card information to the department for the purpose of sharing  
50 and exchanging voter registration information with the  
51 nongovernmental entity.

52 5. If the department becomes a member of a nongovernmental  
53 entity as provided in subparagraph 1., the department must  
54 submit a report to the Governor, the President of the Senate,  
55 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by December 1 of  
56 each year. The report must describe the terms of the  
57 nongovernmental entity membership and provide information on the  
58 total number of voters removed from the voter registration  
59 system as a result of the membership and the reasons for their  
60 removal.

61 Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2019.
