 7 Section 1. Section 705.17, Florida Statutes, is amended to

21 Section 2. Section 705.185, Florida Statutes, is created  
22 to read:

23 705.185 Disposal of personal property lost or abandoned on  
24 the premises of certain facilities.—Whenever any lost or  
25 abandoned personal property is found on any premises located  
26 within a theme park or entertainment complex, as the term is  
27 defined in s. 509.013(9), or operated as a zoo, a museum, or an  
28 aquarium; or on any premises of a public food service  
29 establishment or public lodging establishment licensed under  
30 part I of chapter 509, if the owner or operator of the premises  
31 elects to comply with this section, any lost or abandoned  
32 property must be delivered to the owner or operator of the  
33 premises, who shall take charge of the property and make a  
34 record of the date such property was found. If the property is  
35 not claimed by the owner within 30 days after it is found, or a  
36 longer period of time as may be deemed appropriate by the owner  
37 or operator of the premises, the owner or operator of the  
38 premises must dispose of the property or donate it to a  
39 charitable institution that is exempt from federal income tax  
40 under s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code for sale or  
41 disposal as that charitable institution deems appropriate. The
